
Waveguide Pipe Penetrations



Features:

- ♦ Manufactured in brass with NPT thread type.
- Field locatable and can be installed in a bulkhead panel or modular shielded panel.
- Applicable for the insertion of dielectric materials such as fibre optic cables or gases.
- Applicable for the insertion of liquids and oils; however, if a closed system is not used, the attenuation may be substantially reduced.
- Satisfy fire suppression and hydraulic requirements.

Additional Options:



- Custom sizes available.
- ◆ Dielectric unions are available to maintain isolation from ground should metal piping be utilized on the outside of the shield.
- Insulated pipe penetrations for installation where thermal differences are a concern.
- ♦ A honeycomb waveguide insert for high frequency in gaseous applications up to an attenuation cut off at 18 GHz.

Note: As an industry rule of thumb, the length of a circular waveguide should be at least four times the diameter.
